Bonds

14) Stem Cell Bond- \$5.5 billion for stem cell research.

Initiative Constitutional Amendment

15) Split Roll- Tax commercial property for those with +\$3 million in holdings based on market value, rather than purchase price.

Legislative Constitutional Amendment

16) Affirmative Action- Repeals ban for public employment, education and contracting.

17) Parolee Voting Rights- Allows those on parole to vote.

18) 17-Year-Olds Voting Rights- Allows those who will be 18 by the time of the general to vote in the primary.

19) Property Taxes- Allows +55 & wildfire victims to transfer Prop 13 tax break. New limits on transfer of the tax break when home is transferred from parent to adult child.

Initiative Statute

20) Crime Package - Expands definition of violent crimes ineligible for early release, DNA collection, and penalties on serial theft

21) Rent Control- Allows cities to establish rent control for older properties with some exceptions.

22) Ride Share- Allows drivers to be classified as independent contractors while setting new compensation requirements.

23) Dialysis- UHW measure to change requirements for dialysis clinics.

24) Data Privacy- Creates new disclosure requirement, restrictions and rights to sue relating to collection/use of personal data

25) Bail- Referendum on legislation replacing state's cash bail system.
